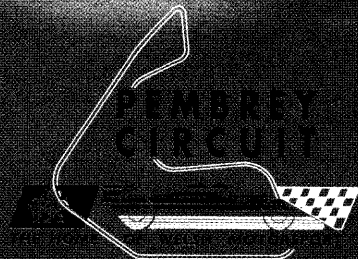

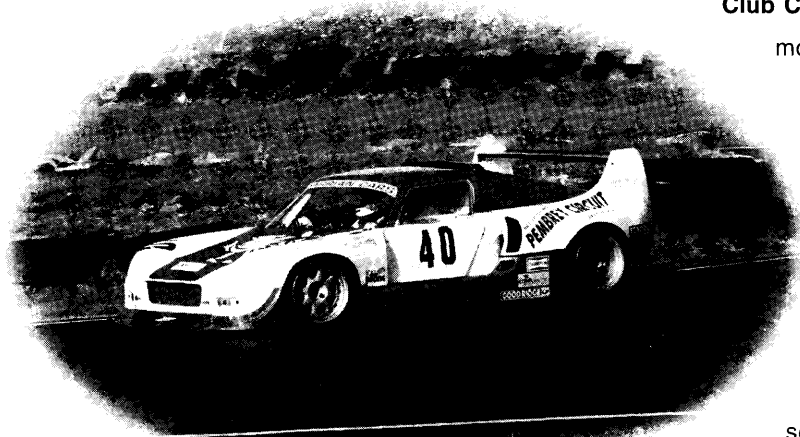

A fine entry has been assembled for the **Royal Purple Austin Healey Club Championship**, which is packed with superbly turned-out models from the British manufacturer. The classic 3000 model dominates the entry in the hands of drivers like **Bruce Montgomery and Steve Bicknell**, but the nimble Sprites can pull off some giant-killing. Montgomery will be as spectacular as ever in his 3000, but **Mike Johns** is a real star in his diminutive Sprite. The **Michelin Porsche Classic Championship** is packed with Pre '84 cars from the German marque. **Spencer Griffiths** is having a superb season and won seven of the first eight races to take a vice-like grip on the title contest. The ever-spectacular **Tony Brown, Patrick Pearce** and **Graham Burke** are amongst his major rivals, while **Steve Smyth** and **Steve Winter** go head to head in class two and



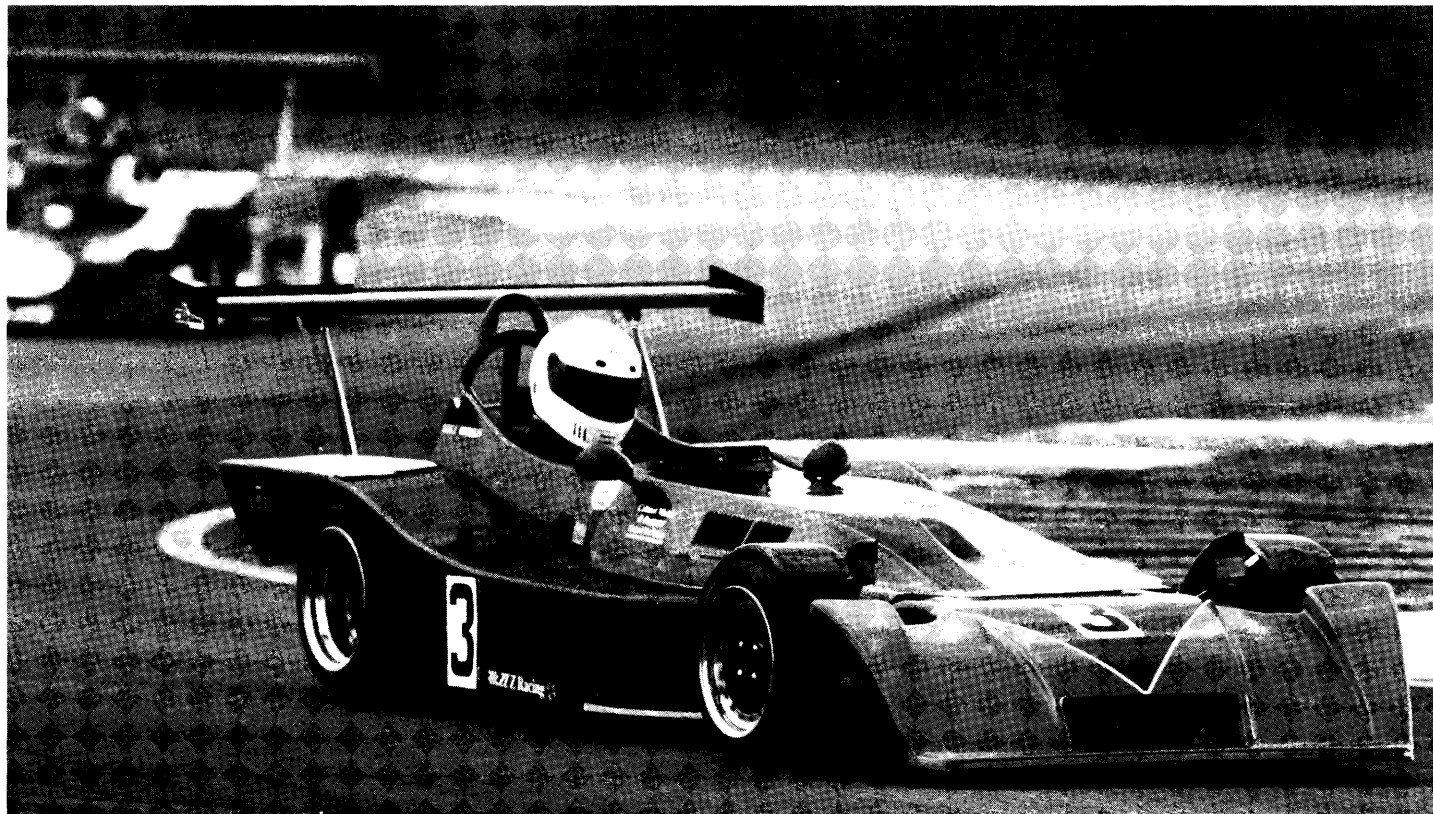

The **Classic Clubmans Championship** is another hit of the 2001 season, with an ever-growing number of pre '80 sports-racing cars appearing on the grid. **Ray Harper's** superbly-presented Phantom P79 should be the car to beat, but **Mike Hickson's** Mallock is back in action after a shunt at Brands in May and should give Harper a good run. A round of the **MAN Trucks Sports Racing and GT Challenge** wrap up the sports car races, with a splendid assortment of replicas including several Cobra-based cars and re-creations of classic cars like the Ford GT40 and Jaguar D Type.

The single-seater action comes from the **BARC/BRSCC Classic Formula Ford 1600** and the **Universal Racing Services Classic Formula Ford 2000 Championships**. **Simon Loynes, Nicholas Pearce**, the ever-improving **Julie Clarke** and **Clive Wood** head the 2-litre cars, but veteran single-seater racer **Will Arif** makes a welcome return with the Reon Motorsport team.

Finally, on Saturday afternoon, a round of the **BARC Wales/WRDA Welsh Sports and Saloon Car Championship** brings out a diverse array of racing machinery, from the former touring car Ford Mondeo of **Alvin Powell** to the Darran T90 of **Peter Dark**. A strong contender should also be the Prosport LM3000 of Carmarthen's **Terry Brown**.

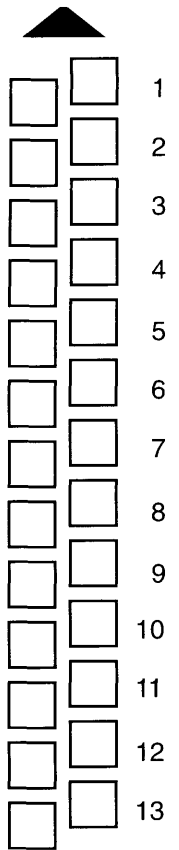

BARC Wales/WRDA Sports Saloon Championship

Permit No. CH01054

The 2001 Welsh Championship for Sports and Saloon Cars is organised and administered by the BARC (Wales) in association with the Welsh Racing Drivers Association, and is being contested over 17 rounds.

Classes: A1 – Modified Sports and Saloon Cars; A2 – Ex-British Touring Cars; B – Production Saloon and One-Make Saloon, and Modified Non-Turbo Saloons (1601cc-2000cc); Production Sports Cars up to 3-litre capacity; C – Modified and Production Cars up to 1600cc; D – Modified Cars not eligible for Class A1 (Darrian, Caterham, Westfield, Silva, Ginetta, Strathcarron); E – Modified Sports, Saloons and 'Specials' not eligible for Class A1, A2, B, C or D.

Points in each class at each round (subject to number of starters): 5, 3, 2, 1 plus 1 for fastest lap. One extra point will be awarded for all competitors participating in practice or 4 race at any events other than at Pembrey. The totals from all qualifying rounds less 2 will determine final championships points and positions.

Awards in each class at each round: Trophy; Championship – Trophy to overall winner; and to class winners.

Rounds: April 7 Pembrey; April 8 Pembrey; May 12 Ty Croes; May 13 Ty Croes; June 9 Pembrey; June 10 Pembrey; June 16 Silverstone; June 23 Pembrey; June 24 Pembrey; July 7 Pembrey; August 4 Ty Croes; August 5 Ty Croes; September 1 Pembrey; September 9 Mallory Park; October 7 Mallory Park; October 20 Pembrey; October 21 Pembrey.
